Happy New Year



2020 Project Round-up

Since the start of the project back in July 2020 we have made significant progress on site. We have:

- Cleared the site of all underground obstructions
- Completed piling works
- Erected four tower cranes
- Poured concrete on buildings D1 and D2
- Basement dug out for building E
- Sitewide infrastructure installed including below ground services for heating and water





Throughout January...

We will start installing the permanent road through site and we will be close to completion on the infrastructure drainage works. Pile caps and drainage works will continue on buildings C1 and C2 and ground floor slabs will be poured. Concrete pours will continue on buildings D1 and D2 reaching the third and second floor respectively. Work will also continue on the basement walls for building E.
